



ABOUT THE POSITION

The Silverthorne Police Department is a small, close-knit team of professional, talented men and women of integrity conducting our work in a way that continues to build the trust necessary for Silverthorne's safety and success.

The Department is looking for a community-minded officer committed to policing from a position of trust and mutual respect, serving with honor and integrity, and becoming a meaningful member of the supportive community. We require that this individual demonstrate respect, dignity, and compassion for everyone; have a passion for public service; meet high ethical standards of honesty and integrity; and stand up for fellow officers and the community with fairness, inclusivity, and professionalism.

Responsibilities include enforcement of criminal and traffic laws, preventing and deterring criminal activity, and providing day-to-day services to the public. Silverthorne utilizes the principles of community policing and problem-oriented policing to address and resolve issues within the Town. We endeavor to begin every interaction from a position of trust and use our Core value statement of, "police others as we would want to be policed and treat others as we would want to be treated" to guide each interaction.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- Colorado POST Certification; the Silverthorne Police Department will pay for qualified applicants to complete police academy and certification.
- ◆ Valid Colorado driver's license
- Two years of completed academic work at the collegiate level
- Applicants must be able to work four 10-hour shifts, that rotate and include, nights, weekends and holidays
- Applicants must be a minimum of 21 years of age
- Must be able to meet the physical requirements as shown in the job description
- Must have the ability to pass a background check, a drug test, a polygraph and psychological testing
- Must submit names of five references in the application process
- No Felony convictions, convictions of Domestic Violence, or other de-certifying misdemeanors as outlined by Colorado POST
- Desire to live and work in Silverthorne

LATERAL OFFICERS MUST:

- Meet the above standards
- Have at least three years of patrol experience at the state or local level and be in good standing with their current department.
- Desire to live and work in Silverthorne
