



NEW LIQUOR LICENSE

Licensing Process

The liquor license process can generally take up to four months to complete, depending on how or what type of license you are applying for. Therefore, you must communicate with the Town Clerk's office far in advance of your intended opening date. Failure to file applications in a timely manner may result in a delay in obtaining your liquor license.

Approval of a liquor license is a two-tiered process in Colorado. Please visit the State of [Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division's website](#) for more information. You will find checklists for each type of liquor license application on that site.
